- 5. Possess current certification in First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation
- 6. Provide references and previous employment information upon request
- 7. Effective communicator

IV. Duties, Responsibilities, and Expectations:

- 1. Report directly to the FBS Director
- 2. Maintain a classroom environment that is safe and academically engaging
- 3. Develop and submit biblically integrated weekly lesson plans to the Director
- 4. Incorporate various teaching materials and methods, using curriculum provided
- 5. Contribute to the total-school program through extra duties and/or club sponsorship
- 6. Plan for personal absences and contact substitutes for each absence
- 7. Maintain consistent communication with parents
- 8. Inform FBS Director of any major concerns with students
- 9. Maintain attendance and grades in the school management software
- 10. Demonstrate professionalism, flexibility, dependability, and kindness
- 11. Maintain a professional appearance
- 12. Adhere to policies and procedures as outlined in the FBS Staff Handbook
- 13. Attend all professional development, staff meetings, devotionals, and training
- 14. Maintain a respectful, Christ-centered relationship with students, parents, and faculty
- 15. Pray regularly for the students and families of FBS
- 16. Work as an effective member of the FBS team and with other ministries of FBC
- 17. Participate in school and combined church/school activities as requested
- 18. Contribute to FBS through extra duties as assigned
